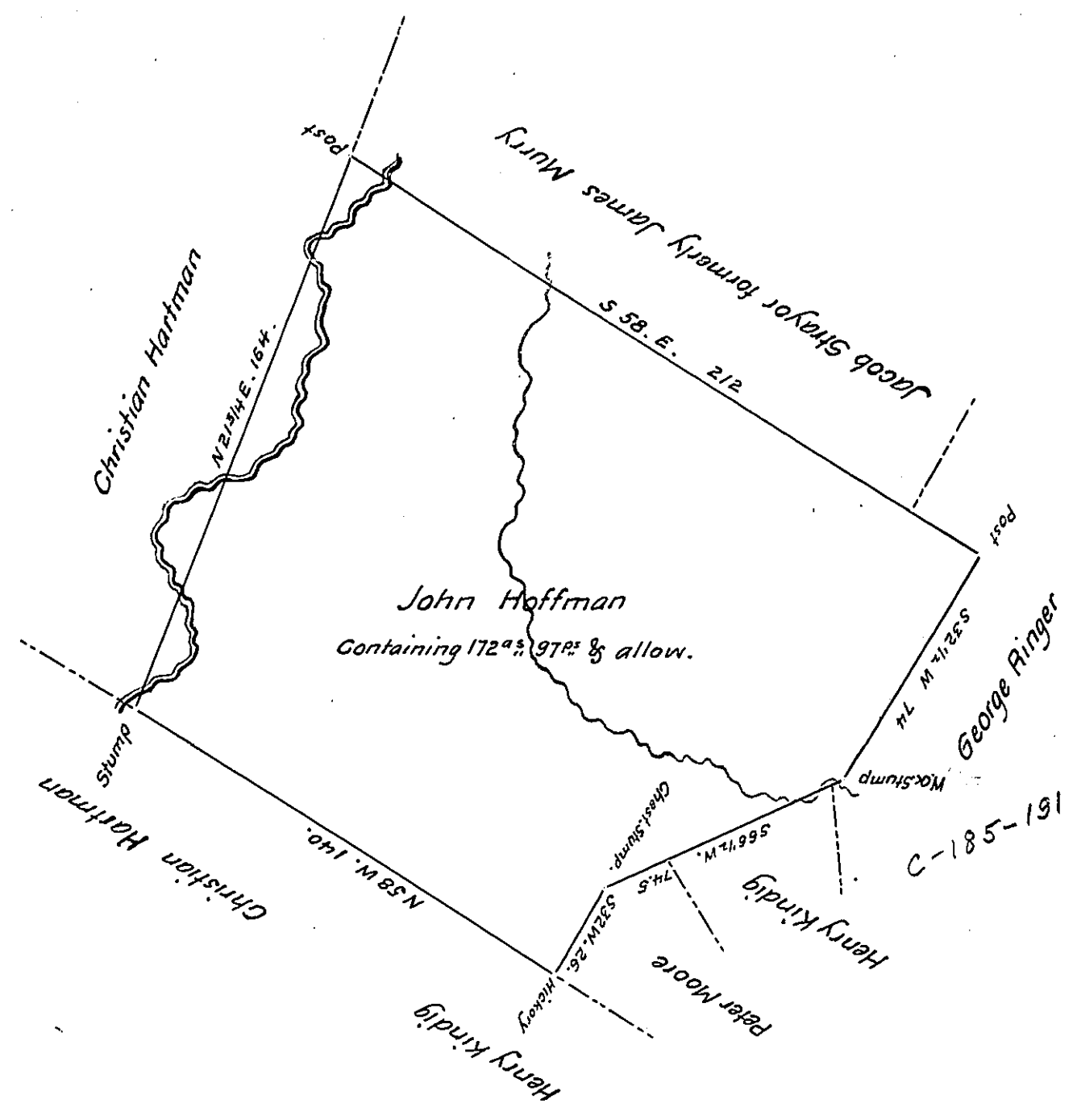


FORM NO 1.

Resurveyed by the old lines on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of December 1828. and Returned per Contract. Owned and occupied by Henry Kindig, Christian Hartman & George Ringer.
