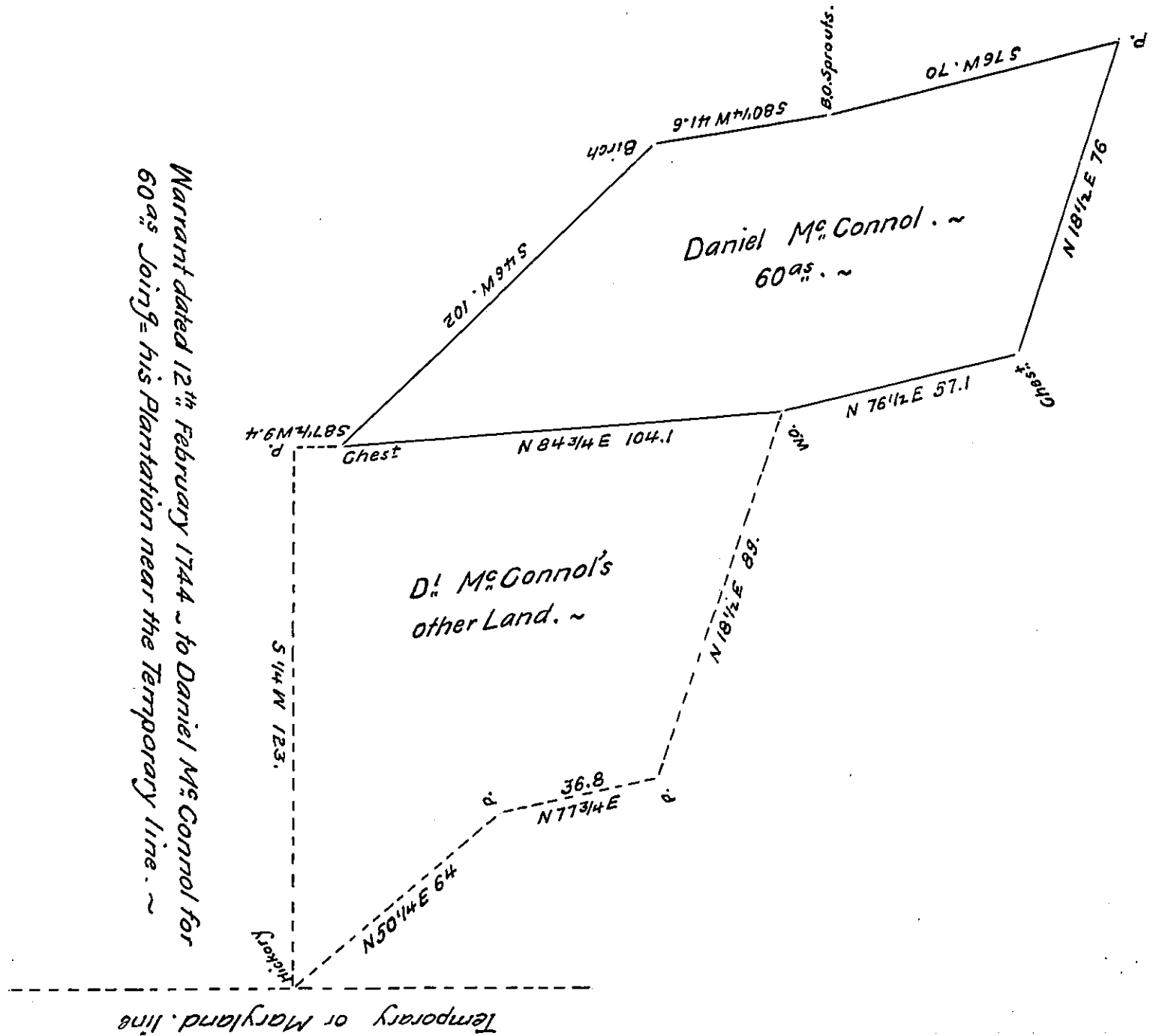


Warrant dated 12th February 1744 ~ to Daniel Mc Connol for 60^{as} Join^g his Plantation near the Temporary line. ~



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office. Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located & surveyed Warrant granted 12th February 1744. to Daniel Mc Connol for 60^{as} Join^g his Plantation near the Temporary line, on Lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram ~ Witness my hand

October 29th 1838.
