



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government & for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant dated 23^d Aug. 1749 to James McClean for 50 Acres, on Lands lying on Gonowago Creek, adjoining Digg's Tract & Robert Owen, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram - Witness my hand.
