The above described Land was first Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Armor for 25^{ac} dated the 30th day of November 1773, afterwards Surveyed and said to be Returned and Patented on a Warrant granted to Simon Evans dated the 16th day of September 1785. Owned and in possession of Jacob Hershey living in Paradise township. Armors Warrant Supp^d abandoned Reported &c. 16th November 1828.
