



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant 25th Sept. 1746. to Alexander M. Candless for 250 acres near the Temporary Line, an Lands situate near the Temporary Line in Germany township Adams County, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram. ~ Witness my hand. ~
