



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day surveyed and located Warrant issued 20th February 1746 to Thomas Neely for 100 acres of Land on Light's line on big Conowago, on Lands situate on the line of Jacob Light & on big Conowago, in Reading Township Adams County, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram. Witness my hand.
