In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the Recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or Other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 27th Sept^r. 1743. to Andrew Rogers for 100^{ac} at or near big Conowago, on Lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram. ~ Witness my hand. ~
