Note. ~ The same tract of land was included in a survey made the 23^d day of October 1769 for William M^cCorkle in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 & is designated by the Green lines & is now owned by the heirs of Major Keen in right of the said William M^cCorkle.
