Note ~ The same tract of land interferes & is included in a Survey made the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November 1774 for Abraham Whitmer in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> of November 1773 and now owned by Leonard Smith in right of the said Abraham Whitmer and is by the Green lines
