



*Situate in Hartleton township Union County Surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September 1835 by Virtue of a Warrant Granted to Jacob Mecklin Dated the 31<sup>st</sup> of Dec<sup>r</sup>. 1773. Containing One Hundred & twenty five acres & fifty-seven perches with the usual allowance &c.*

*Note. - The same tract of land was surveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1773 for Isaac Zimmerman in pursuance of his Warrant Dated the 7<sup>th</sup> of June 1773. & now owned by Charles Books in right of the said Isaac Zimmerman.*
