 1793. & the part marked B. is included within the lines of a tract of 481 1/2 acres
 on a warrant to William Walker dated 8 Sept^r 1786, owned by Cornelius
 Garrettsine & Co. under the ~~title~~ said titles to Leeper & Walker. Note Endorsed
 on the Draught of Leeper; that a part of the land intended for his warrant was
 taken by Walkers warrant.
