



Situate in Heidelberg township formerly Mannheim in the county of York surveyed in pursuance of an Application No. 2551. Granted to Jacob Godshelck dated January the 22^d 1767, the 30 day of May 1831. The above tract of land is owned and in possession of Abraham Gerber, Jacob Thriber, and Jacob Bollinger the whole thereof is included in a patent granted to John Hoover the 17th day of August, 1772, or a warrant granted to Andrew Hershey dated the 24th day of October 1738, but no evidence of Godshelck (the name of the office right) ever being in possession or ever claimed it:
