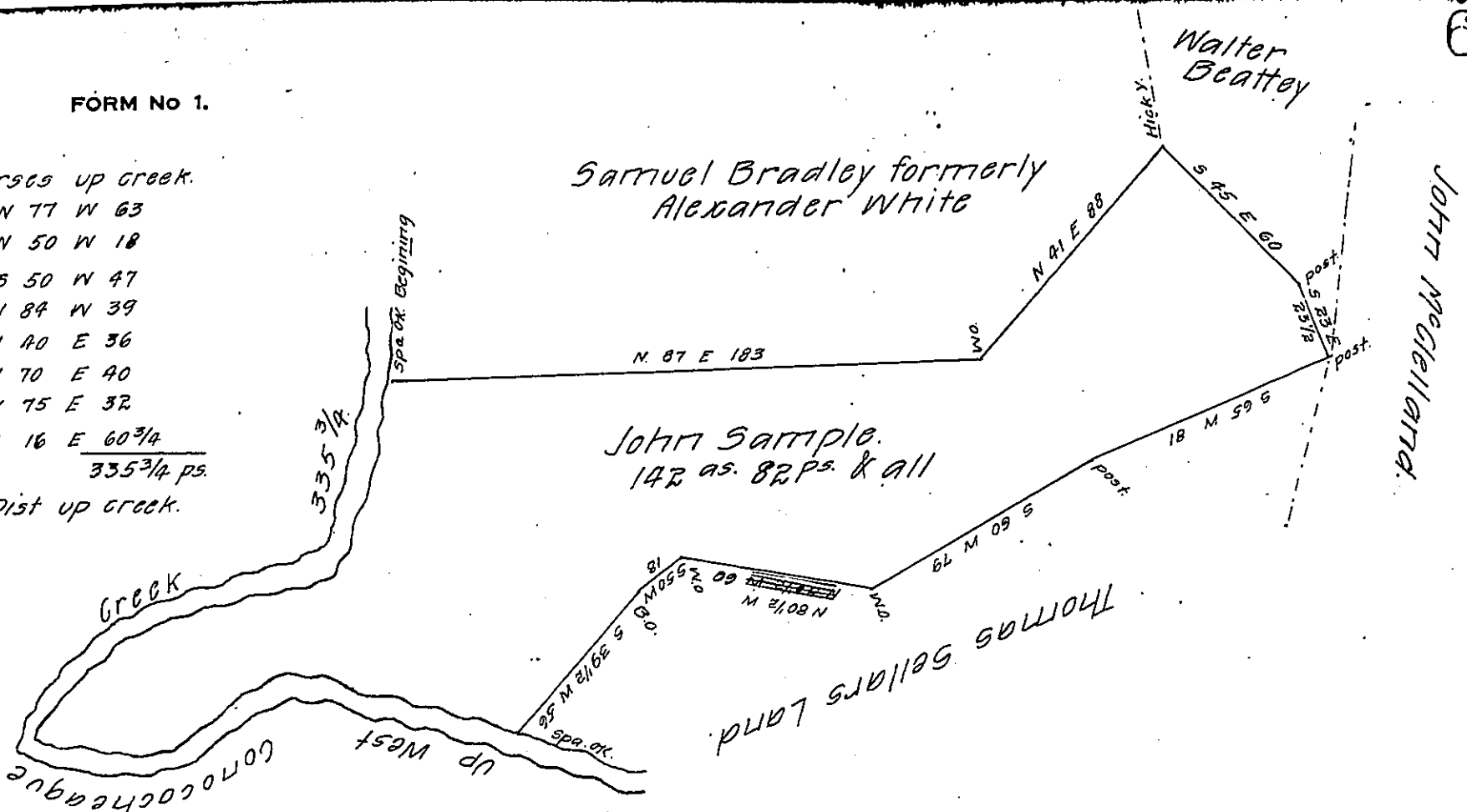

Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township Franklin county containing one hundred & forty two acres eighty two perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. which was surveyed the - day of - by William Lyon assistant to John Armstrong Esqr. formerly Deputy Surveyor on an application granted John Sample for 100 acs of land on the east side of West Conococheague Creek joining Thomas Sellars John McClean Alexander White in Peters township dated the 5<sup>th</sup> of December 1766 No. 2091 Certified the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1830 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.

The land above described is wholly the same as a survey containing 142 1/2 acs. & all which is said to have been surveyed in pursuance of two warrants one dated the 18<sup>th</sup> of November 1741 granted Alexander Brown the other dated the 3<sup>d</sup> of February 1755 granted John Sample under which survey the present owner claims.
