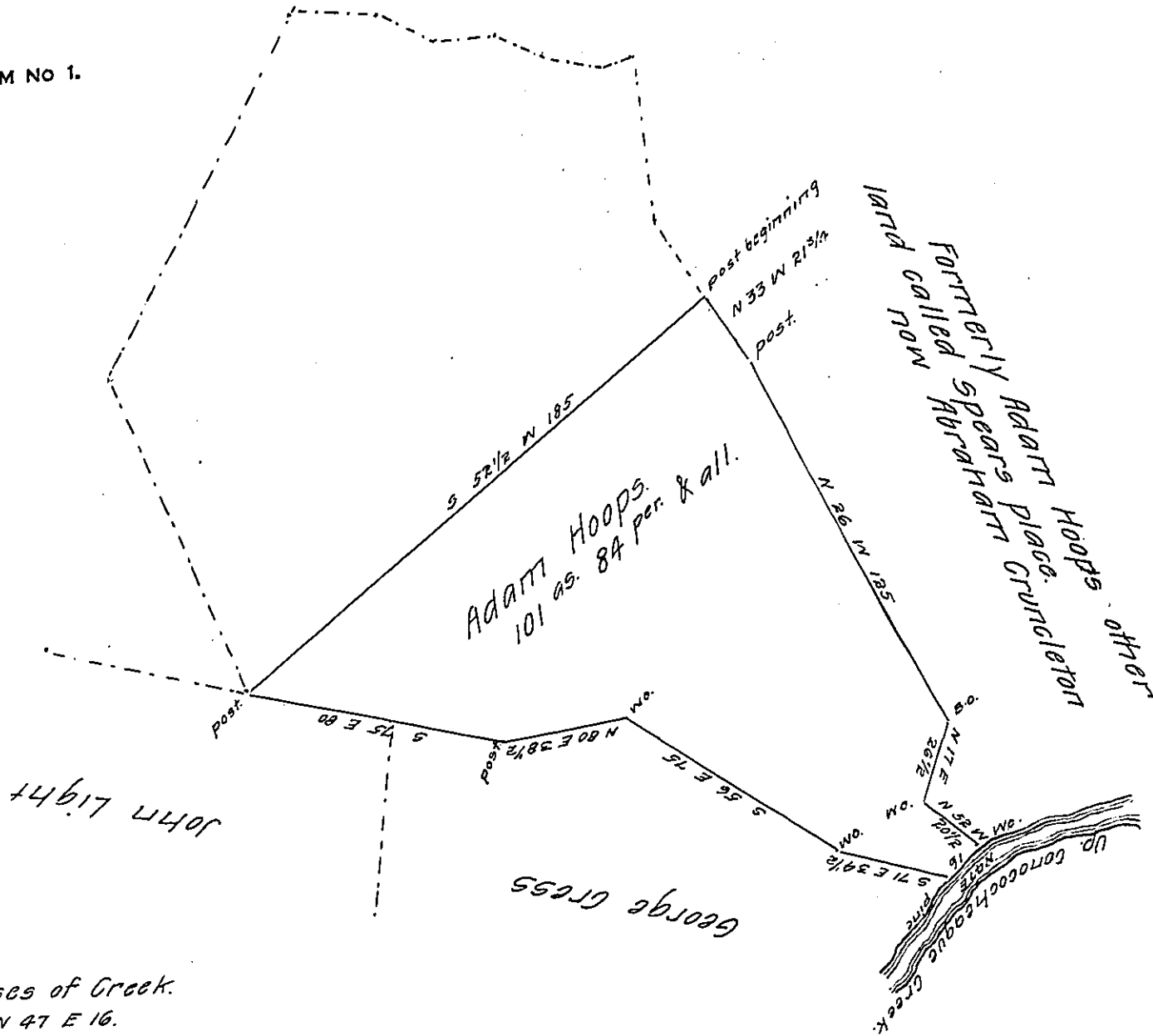

Located the 16th of Feb^y. 1830 (on an Application granted Adam Hoops for 100^{acs} of land joining his other land formerly called Spears place on Conococheague- & Antrim township dated the 6th of January 1767 No. 2313) In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights. &c.
