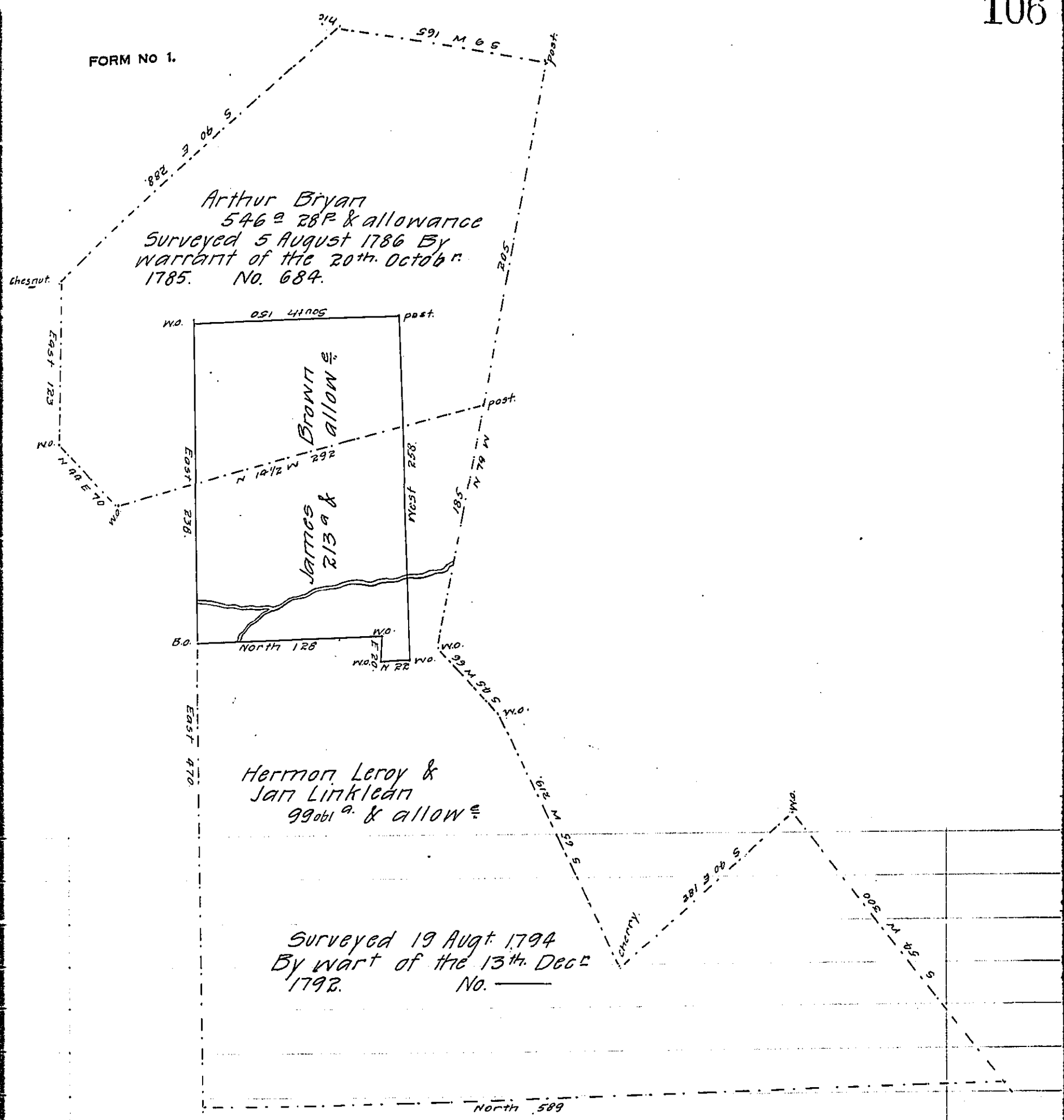


FORM NO 1.



The shaded lines in the above diagram represent a survey made to James Brown on the 16th of May 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed. The land called for by James Brown warrant is found to lie north of the purchase of 1768 and within the purchase of 1784. The dotted lines above represent the new purchase surveys, the warrantee names dates & numbers ^{are} ~~are~~ inserted in the drafts respectively ~~as above~~. The survey of James Brown includes the farm of Peter Grotzer Esquire who claims under the title to Hermon Leroy & Jan Linklean
