



" Situate on Browns run on the west side of Monongahela River, on the road leading from Uniontown to little White Clay (alias Whitely) creek in German township, Fayette County and surveyed the 7th day of June 1785 in pursuance of two warrants, the one granted to Joseph Cox dated the first day of April 1773 (obl)nd other granted to Andrew Robb the 15th day of April 1785.

The above described land, is now in the occupancy of the heirs of And^w Robb dec^d and claimed by And^w Robb.
