The dotted lines and the letters A. B. C in the above diagram represent a survey made to Henry Hill the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed. It will be seen that the land called for by Henry Hills warrant has been previously surveyed and appropriated by Jacob Wolf Jun<sup>r</sup> in pursuance of a warrant dated the 22<sup>d</sup> of March 1786. The land is in the occupancy of Robert Robison and John Gerry who claim under the title to Jacob Wolf Jun<sup>r</sup> there does not appear to be any one claiming under the title of Henry Hill
