



The shaded lines in the above diagram represent a survey made to George Irwin on the 6th of March 1828. A return whereof is herewith enclosed. The land called for by George Irwin's warrant is found to be north of the purchase of 1768 and with the purchase of 1784. The surveys represented by the dotted lines above were made at the time and by the authority therein stated under which the land of George Irwin is claimed, it is unseated. It is not ascertained that any person now claims under the title to George Irwin.
