



The dotted lines including the letters A. B. C. D. in the above diagram represent a survey made on the 20th March 1828 to James Ramsey by warrant of the 14th August 1773. A return whereof is herewith enclosed. The dates of the interfering surveys are stated in the drafts respectively. It will be seen that Ramsey's survey has been made upon the ground called for it & is occupied by Daniel Campbell who claims under the title of John Hart. The tract warranted in trust for the heirs of Francis Lathiers is patented and is owned by the said heirs who are not yet of age.
