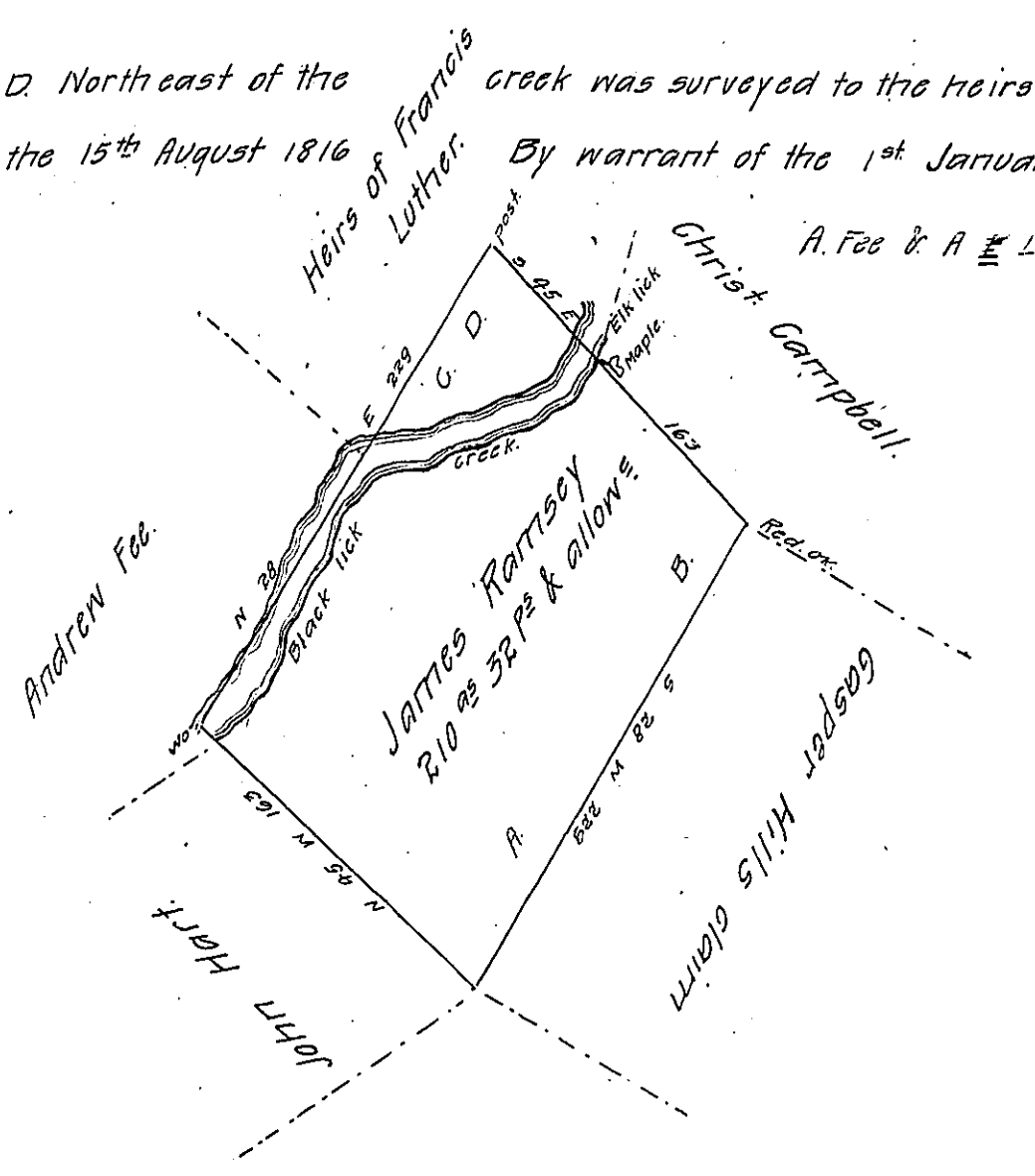

In pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other office titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and by the authority of the Board of Property. I have this 20th day of March 1828 Surveyed the above described tract of two hundred and ten acres and thirty two perches and allowance of six per cent joining the Elklick Creek below the mouth of Brush run above the run running from M^{rs} Donalds to Blacklick Creek and adjoining lands of the heirs of Frances Louthers Andrew Fee and others. Situate in Wheatfield township Indiana County By virtue of a warrant granted to James Ramsey the 14th day of August 1773.
