

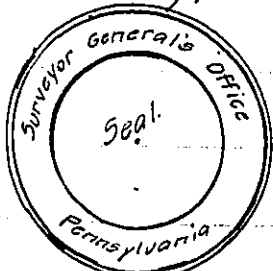
Situate in Peach Bottom (late Fawn) township in the County of York Con-
