


FORM NO 1.



The plane lines in the above diagram represent the survey of Robert Wallace, the return of which I herewith enclose, you will perceive that the land called for by Wallaces warrant has been surveyed to James Elder, the date of whose survey & warrant I have put down in the diagram, For the satisfaction of the Board of property I have represented by dotted lines the adjoiners called for by Wallaces warrant have put down in each survey the warrantee name the date of survey and warrant and the names of the persons for whom they were made all of which I collected from the original field notes which happen to be in my possession. The James Elder tract, is owned by the heirs of Thomas Wiggins who settled up on it about the year 1814 and ^{it} is now in the occupancy of his widow and children whose improvement is included within the survey now made for Robert
