Gables shows no papers or titles &c. the other part where the letter B is placed contains 8<sup>a</sup>. & allowances and George Upp is the present owner in rt. of Michael Seltzer &c. the same was surveyed for Seltzer by John Forsyth D.S the 24<sup>th</sup> May 1797 in pursuance of a warrant in two pieces dated 8<sup>th</sup> June 1786. Granted for 35<sup>a</sup>. afterwards disputed by B. Zeller &c. Surveyed the above on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May A. D. 1831.
