



Application 5074, 23d June, 1768, to John Brandon for 50 as in
Huntington Township.

In pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes. I have this day located and surveyed Appn - 5074 granted 23d June, 1768 to John Brandon for 50 as in Huntington Township, on lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
