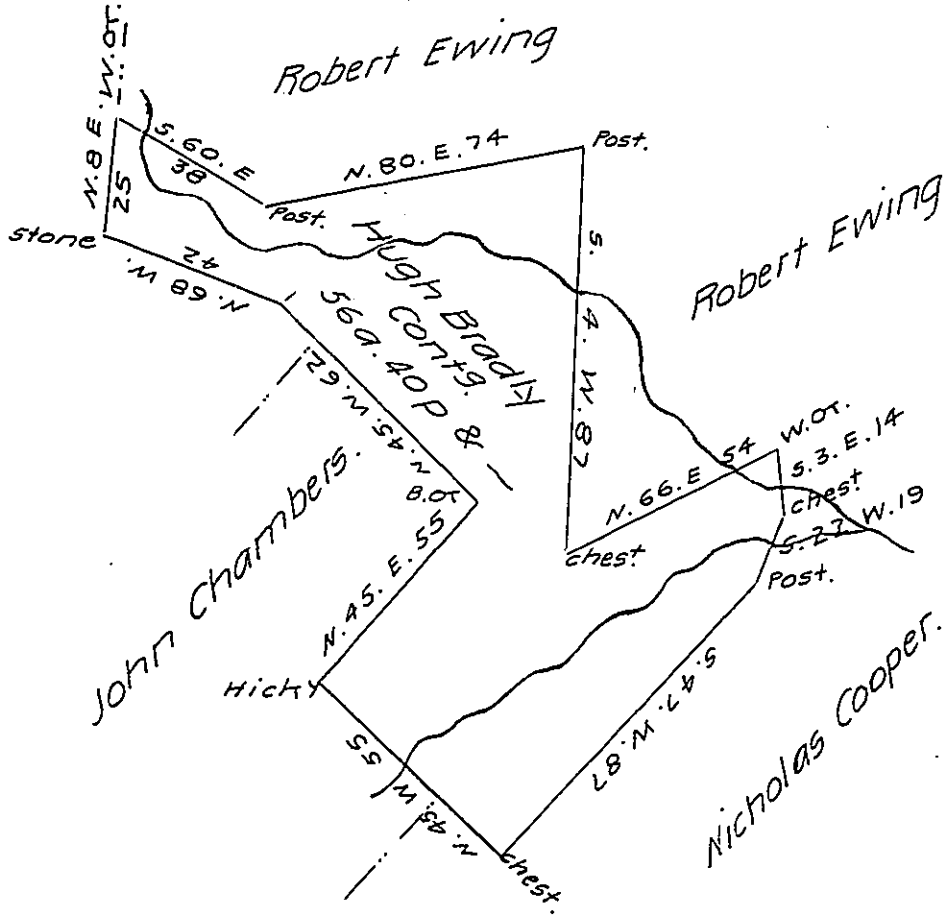


*Conningham Sample.*
