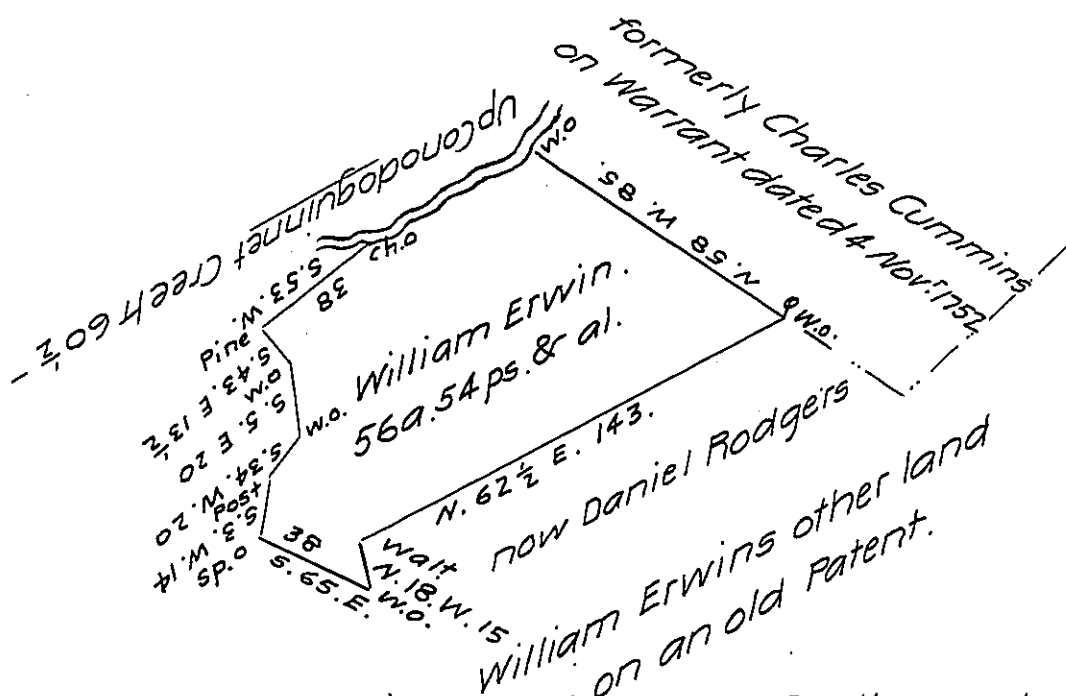

 a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the
 several acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under
 Proprietary Rights &c. And by virtue of an order of Survey
 dated 16 August, 1768, No. 5130, granted William Erwin for 50
 acres "joining David Herran, William Erwin, and Charles
 Cummins in Lurgan Township. Ascertained on premises
 17 September 1829

Report. The above tract is wholly the same as a tract
 survy'd 10th May, 1787, on a warrant (presumed) to the same
 William Irwin for 50 acres bearing date 21 February 1787, &
 held under said title. Daniel Rodgers owner, James McPerson
 occupant.

Note. No evidence of the above location having been execu-
 ted on the land. W. Irwin. Pat'd.
