The part A. Containing 1905.148 perches was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Philip Zeigler for 2000 dated the 6 of July, 1790, and the part B, containing 530.92 perches was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant for 500 granted to said Zeigler dated 15 January 1789 the whole owned and occupied by John Behler and said to be patented.
