



Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County containing three hundred & one acres thirteen perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 29th of August 1829 (on an application granted John Kennedy for 300 as of land bounded on David Kennedy & John Otes, Adam Armstrong & Peter Riter in Peters township dated the 29th of May 1769 No 5499). In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary rights &c.

The part of the above survey marked A is the same as a survey of 245 as 113 per & all, which was surveyed on a warrant granted Henry Stahl dated the 24th of July, 1784, the part marked B is the same as a survey of 55 as 55 per & all which was surveyed on a warrant granted Martin Derode dated the 4th of Feb'y, 1813.
