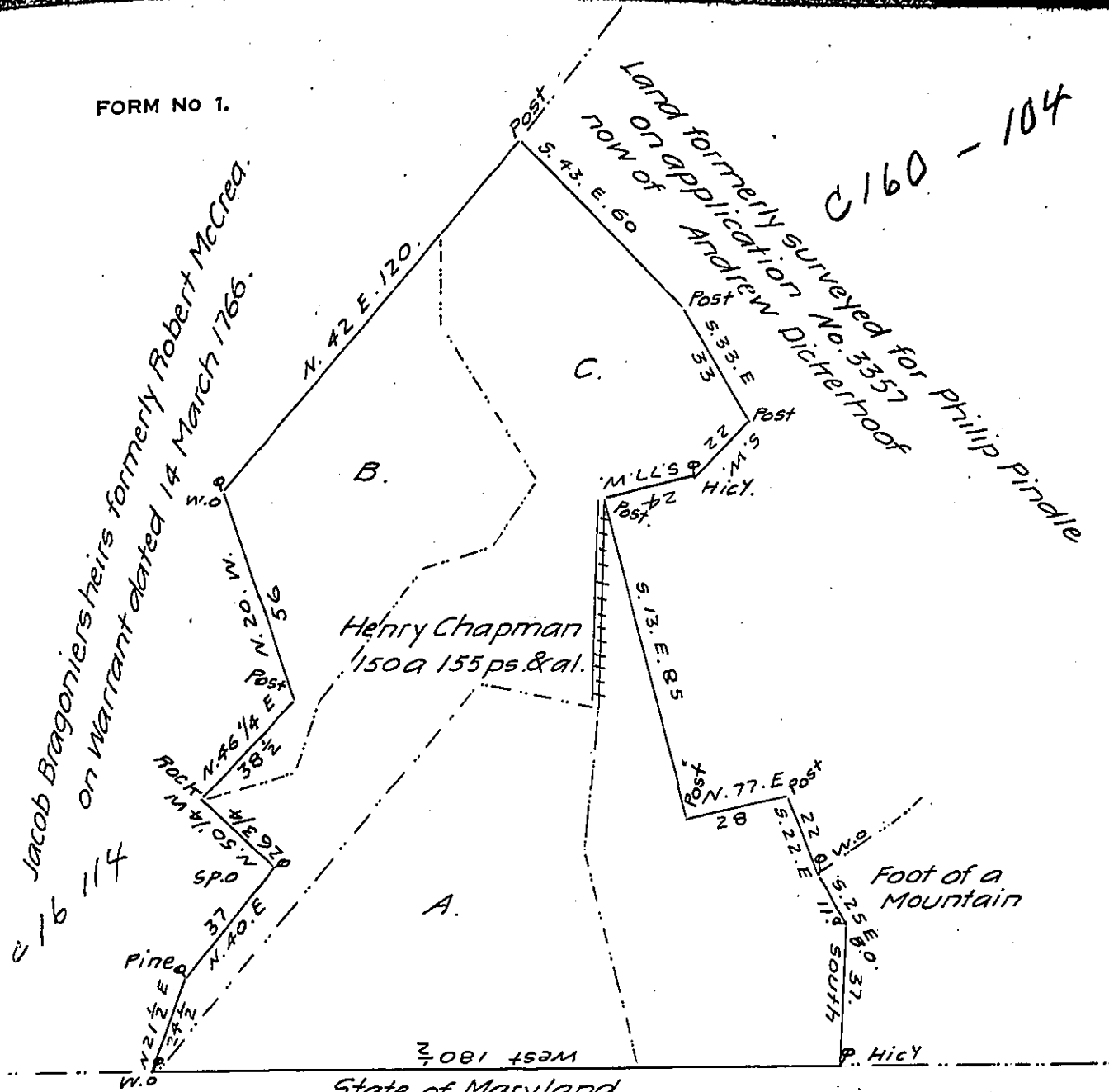

State of Maryland  
 A Draught of a tract of land situate in Warrentownship, Franklin County  
 (formerly Air Township Cumberland Coty) containing one hundred & fifty  
 acres one hundred & fifty five perches & allowance of six per cent. for roads &c.  
 surveyed 24 May 1831, in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property  
 for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to unpatented  
 lands under Proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of an Application No. 5496  
 dated 27 May 1769, entered in name of Henry Chapman for 300 acres "In the  
 little cove joining the province line on the South, Nicholas Straver on the north  
 & Robert McCrea on the West." William S. Davis Contractor.

To Jacob Spangler Esqr, Surveyor General. Report. The above tract is cover-  
 ed in part by the following office rights, to wit: The dotted lined figure A is sup-  
 posed to be covered by a survey of 44 acres 24 perches on warrant to Francis  
 Coon dated 18 March 1790, lines not found. The figure B represented by dot-  
 ted lines is covered by a survey 27 as 99 ps on a warrant to Thomas Fowler  
 & Abraham Hellar dated 21 February 1794. Also 40 acres of the remain-  
 der at the place marked C, is claimed under a warrant to Leonard Gra-  
 ham dated 3 March 1794. Although the above is the location of Chapman's  
 order, yet no evidence appears of title derived from said Chapman.  
 Francis Coon, pat'd in Bedford Co for entry. W. S. DAVIS -  
 Fowler & Hellar, pat'd in Bedford Co. L. Graham not P. in Bedford Co.
