Application 5572. 17th Augt 1769, granted to Martin Miller for 60 acres, about 3 miles from McCalisterstown, in Manheim Township

In pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes. I have this day located and surveyed Appⁿ 5572, 17th Augt 1769 to Martin Miller for 60 acres, on lands situate formerly in Manheim (now I believe) Heidleberg Township, about 2 miles from McCalisterstown (now Hanover) and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand.
