require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed to the said Samuel Guldin
according to the method of Townships appointed the said quantity of eight hundred
acres of land in the said township of Strasburg and make returns thereof into the
Secretaries office which survey in case the said Samuel on his part fulfill the said a-
greem^t shall be valid, otherwise the same shall be void as if it had never been
made nor this Warr^t ever granted Given under our hands and the seal of the
Province at Philadelphia the first day of the first month A. D. 171^{3/4}.
