At ye request of William Hudson late arrived, yt I would grant him
to take up two hundred acres of land one ~~hundred~~^{or} Purchase & one hund-
red at rent on Darby creek in ye County of Chester. These are to will & re-
quire three fourths to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd
number of Acres in ye afore mentioned County & ~~to be~~ provided it be
not already taken up according to ye method of township appointed by me,
and make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia,
ye 22^d of ye 10th mo. 1683.

ditto, ordered C.A. to lay it out at or near Darby creek in the ^{new} method of townships
after former wants & next to Jo: Barbridge.
