These are therefore in ye Proprietary name to will, and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye said fifty acres (of what is not already taken up) contiguous to this two hundred acres aforesaid and make returne of ye two hundred and of ye fifty as one tract unto ye Secretary's Office. Dated at Philadelphia the 14 of ye 4th mo. 1690.
