At the request of Margaret German widow of John German that we would grant her a resurvey on one hundred acres of land laid out in the township of Radnor within the Welch tract by virtue of a general warrant from the Prop^{rs} for laying out the said tract dated the 13th of the fifth month 1684 in right of John Evans Purchaser under Richard Davies These are to require thee to resurvey to the s^d Margaret German the said quantity of one hundred acres now in her possession and make returns into the General Surveyor's office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee certified by the Secretary ~~and~~ who is also ~~to~~ to take a duplicate of this return into his office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^a the 18th of the 12th moth 1701.
