

By order & direction from y^e Govern^r & Counse^{ll} for setting out of land to y^e purchisers & in pensallvania I hereby ordered thee to survey & lay out unto Will Withers or his assigns fower hundred & ninety akers of land on y^e east eren side of Chichester crick next contiguous to John Johnson lands & next lay out to Henry Hastings & Richard Buffington fower hundred acours for w^{ch} said last mentioned land I have received a warrant from y^e Govern^r & when done to returne unto me an exact duplicate of y^e originall field worke & protracted figurs which are to remain in my office dated this 13th 7mo 1682.

or any of them who is to observe y^e rule of twenty pole to y^e hundred acres if y^e place will bare it backward.
