Surveyed for William Hughes 146 acres of land lying in the township of Chester beginning at a marked post standing near the river side and at the corner of a land which land runs up between the said William Hughes and Wooley Rawson and up the said land N. N. W 410 p'artch, - to a marked post and from thence E b N. 60 p'artch - to a marked post and from thence S. S. E. 370 p'artch - to a marked gum standing by a branch side and over the branch on several courses to a marked post stand by the river side and from thence a long down the river to the first mentioned post.
