At ye request of Joseph Humphry, yt I would grant him to take up one hundred acres, ~~one~~ late purchase in y^e County of Chester in Darbey creek. These are to will & require three fourths to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him ye sd number of acres in ye aforementioned County & place provided it be not already taken up, wth due regards to purchasers, according to ye method of townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof into my Secretarys office Given at Philadelphia ye 22^d of ye 10th mo. 1683.
