Upon request of John Harding Purchaser, yt I would grant him to take up two hundred & fifty acres in ye County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be surveyd in ye remaining part of ye township of Concord, ye aforementioned number of acres, according to ye method of townships by me appointed, & make return thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Chester ye 6<sup>th</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup> mo 1682
