At ye request of John Holstone, yt I would grant him to take up two  
hundred & fifty acres in ye township of Providence in ye County of Chester.  
These are to will & require three fourths to survey or cause to be surveyd unto  
him ye sd number of acres in ye aforementioned County & township, provided  
it be not taken up, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given  
at Philadelphia, ye 24<sup>th</sup> <sup>11<sup>th</sup></sup>/<sub>1776</sub> 1683.
