 Daughter Latitia Penn now Latitia Aubry to lay out unto John Rentrout one hun-
 dred ~~hundred~~ acres of land in the said Latitia's Manor on the west side of
Brandivine Creek in the County of _____ There was surveyd and laid out
 unto ~~John~~ Samuel Hall (to whom ye sd. Rentrout sold his right) the said
 quantity of one hundred acres of land in ye said place Beginning at a Black
 oak in a line of Marlborough township and running by the said line East 127
 perches to a hickery tree Thence south by vacant land 126 perches to a hick-
 ery tree Then west by the land of Gacy Miller & other land 127 perches to a
 Black oak Then north 126 pches to the place of the Beginning.
