At the request of William Hudson of Philadelphia that I would grant him to
take up on resurvey five hundred acres of land formerly laid out to him in right
of Edw^d Atkinson and William Cornthwaite Purchasers of one thousand acres,
out of one of the ~~(the)~~ tracts of one thousand each ~~formerly~~ laid out to himself Jno.
Cornwell, Tho: Langhorn and Arthur Burdall near Brandywine Creek in the County
of Chester. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey and lay out or cause
to be resurvey'd and laid ~~out~~ to the sd W^m Hudson the sd number of
five hundred acres out of one of ~~the~~ tracts afores^d. And make returns
thereof into my Secretaries office. Given under my hand and seal at Philadelphia
the 20th day of ye first moth 1700/1
