



Pennsylvania s.s.

By the Commissioners of Property

*At the request of Hans Graef of or near Conestoga that we would grant him to take up near the same place the quantity of eleven hundred & fifty acres of land for which he agrees to pay to the use of the trustees one hundred and fifteen pounds money of Pennsylvania for y^e whole and the yearly quitrent of one shilling sterling for every hundred acres thereof. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed unto the said Hans Graef at or near Conestoga aforesaid according to the method of Townships appointed the said quantity of eleven hundred and fifty acres of land that has not been already surveyed nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make returns thereof into y^e Secretarys Office which survey in case y^e said Hans fulfill the above agreement within three months after the date hereof shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this warrant ever granted. Given under our hands and the seal of y^e Province at Philadelphia the 4th day of October Anno Dni 1718. Rich^d Hill
