to be four hundred acres. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause
to be resurvey'd the said tract according to the ~~first~~^{true} bounds and lines of sur-
vey, and make returns thereof into my Secretaries office. Given under my hand and
seal at Philadelphia the third of the first month 1709.*
