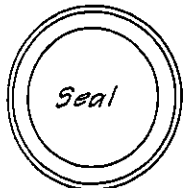


Pennsylvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property

At the request of Henry Hayes That we would grant him to take up the remainder untaken up of the Original Purchase made by Richard Hannids of Swarford in the County of Oxford of one thousand acres of land These are to authorize and require thee to survey and lay out to the said Henry Hayes the quantity of four hundred and eighty four acres of land being the quantity untaken up that has not been already survey'd nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians according to the method of townships appointed, and make returns into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia, where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delv'd to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 28<sup>th</sup> day of the eleventh month 1705.
