These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey the sd tract according to the true bounds and lines by which the same was at first sett out distinguishing between the fast land thereof and ye adjacent Marsh, and make returns into the General Surveyors office at Philad^{ia} where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary.
