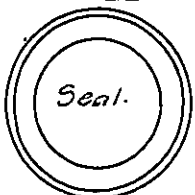

At the request of Joseph Fisher. That we would grant him a resurvey on a certain tract of land Situate in the County of Philadelphia between the lands of Samuel Carpenter Gwinnedd Richd Hillard Pierce &c. laid out for four thousand four hundred and twenty acres in right of the said Joseph's original Purchase of five Thousand acres from the Proprietary. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Joseph Fisher the said tract of land according to its first bounds and true lines of survey and make returns into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 6th of the 2^d moth 1702.
