By virtue of a warrant from ye Proprietary & Govern^r bearing date the 22^d of the 9th month last (directed to me) I hereby Certify into his Secretary's office, yt I have caused to be surveyed and set out unto W^m Nicholas Purchaser, his city Lott in Philadelphia the 24th of ye 3^d month, w^{ch} said Lott is situate between the third and fourth street from Del (a-b-l) containing in breadth fifty foot and in length one hundred seventy eight, bounded north w^{ard} w^{ch} the back of High street Lotts eastward w^{ch} ye Lott of Matthew Souly southward w^{ch} Chestnut street formerly called Wynne street, westward w^{ch} J^r Copper's Lott and is accordingly entered and recorded in my office. Philadelphia this 29th of ye 3^d mo. 1684.
