By virtue of a warrant from the Commission^{rs} surveyed unto Anthony Morris Samuel Carpenter & David Lloyd trustees appointed by the meeting of friends in Philadelphia the Liberty land, belonging to George Fox late of Swarthmore in the Kingd^m of England originall Purchaser deceased. Beginning at a corner post being the corner of Arnold Castles land thence north north west by a line of marked trees fifty six perches to a corner post of ~~John Mitchener~~ Nicholas Wallers land thence west south west by a line of marked trees fifty six perches and a halfe to a post in John Mitcheners line. Thence south south east by the same fifty six perches to a post for another corner. Thence east north east by the said Arnold Castles land and the land of faire hill meeting house fifty six perches and a halfe to the place of beginning Containeing twenty acres of land Surveyed and layed out the first day of the first month Anno y^e domy 1704/5
