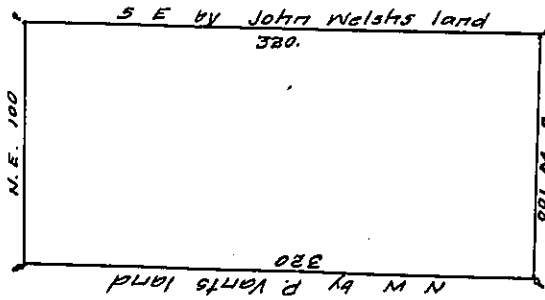

By virtue of the Commission^{rs} warrant dated the 20th of the 8th mo. 1712 I do cer-
 tify that there was surveyd unto Thomas ffairman two hundred acres of land in
 the county of Philladelphia beginning at a corner post of Peter Wents land thence
 northeast by the upper line of Bristol township one hundred perches unto a cor-
 ner post of land belonging to John Welsh three hundred and twenty perches
 thence northwest by the same
~~thence~~ to another post for a corner thence southwest by vacant land one hun-
 dred perches to a whit oke saplin marked for a corner thence southeast by the
 said Wents land three hundred and twenty perches to the first mentioned corner post
 containing two hundred acres of land and is accordingly returned into the
 survey^r Generalls offic at Philladelphia ye 26 of the first month March 1713
