By ord<sup>e</sup> and direction from ye Capt W<sup>m</sup> Markham Depty Govern<sup>r</sup> and Com<sup>rs</sup>  
 for setting out lands to Purchasers and Planters in Pennsylvania, bearing date  
 ye 7<sup>th</sup> of ye 6<sup>th</sup> mo 82. Directed to me I hereby certifie into ye Proprietary  
 and Govern<sup>r</sup>s Secretarys office yt I have caused to be surveyed and set  
 out ye 28<sup>th</sup> of ye said mo. unto Josuah ffearn in part of his Purchas of  
 five hundred acres, <sup>in pt therof</sup> two hundred and fifty acres of land in ye County of  
 Chester, Beginning at a corne<sup>r</sup> marked Gum tree standing by Muckruler Creek  
 being ye corne<sup>r</sup> marked tree of Luke Harick from thence E. N. E. by ye said  
 Haricks line of marked trees 580 perches to a corne<sup>r</sup> marked white  
 oak, from thence N. S. W. by a line of marked trees 64 perches to a  
 corne<sup>r</sup> marked white oak from thence N. S. W. by a line of marked trees  
 680 perches to a corne<sup>r</sup> marked white oak standing by ye said creek from  
 thence by ye creek side on severall Courses to ye first mentioned Gum  
 tree and is accordingly entred and recorded in my office Philadelphia this  
 18<sup>th</sup> of ye 5<sup>th</sup> month 1684.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in  
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of  
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
